Student, Spouse (if applicable) and each parent of a dependent student in the household who earned income from work, did not file a tax return and did not receive a W-2 form or who did receive a 1099 form for work, must submit this form.

Household Employee: A household employee is hired to do household work with the employer determining what work is to be done and how it is to be done. Some examples of household employees include babysitters, housekeepers, and gardeners. A household employee should receive and must submit a W-2 form if they earned more than \$2,200 from a single employer (see IRS Publication 926). If they did not receive a W-2 form, they must file a tax return.
